You can help control the spread of infection with these best practices



Clean your hands frequently and for at least 20 seconds with alcohol-based sanitizer. If sanitizer is not available, use soap and water.



Avoid touching your mask, eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.



While on the campus, you are required to wear a Baycrest-issued mask at all times and eye protection when in client areas.



Maintain a physical distance of 2 metres (6 feet) at all times. No touching/hugging etc.



Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.



Stay home when you are sick.

Safety Requirements for Visitors

While you are at Baycrest, it is important to follow the rules below that have been put in place to protect yourself, the person you are visiting and the staff:

- Wear the mask provided to you at the entrance at all times. The mask must cover your nose and mouth. Please also wear the eye protection provided.
- Good hand hygiene is critical - please wash your hands frequently.
- Maintain a physical distance of 6 feet or 2 metres between yourself and others.
- When you are visiting indoors:
 - Do not enter an elevator or any other space where you can't maintain a 6 foot or 2 metre distance.
 - You may only visit the person you are scheduled to see in their room.

Please ensure you adhere to Baycrest's policies and procedures as described above. These measures are being put in place for the safety of everyone at Baycrest. Please note that if the policies and procedures outlined in this document are not followed, your visit will be discontinued.
